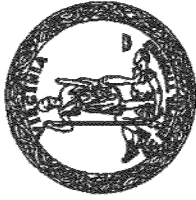

## Operational Requirements and/or Restrictions

**CERTIFICATE RENEWAL** This certificate must be renewed annually. You are not required to renew this certificate annually if you have an active U.S. DOT number issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and are registered under the Unified Carrier Registration Program. A renewal notice will be sent from DMV to the most recent mailing address you have reported to DMV's Motor Carrier Services. If you do not receive a renewal application by your renewal month, contact DMV to obtain an application or download an OA144M application at [dmvnow.com](http://dmvnow.com) under forms. If you do not renew your certificate, you may be required to repeat the certificate application process. An expired certificate may lead to the cancellation of vehicle registrations and license plates issued to the motor vehicle(s) used to conduct the operations authorized by this certificate.

**ADDRESS CHANGE** You must report in writing any new address to DMV's Motor Carrier Services within 30 days.

**DISCONTINUING SERVICE** If you go out of business or stop providing the service authorized by this certificate, you must notify DMV in writing within 30 days.

**INSURANCE** You were required to file proof of liability insurance with DMV's Motor Carrier Services before this certificate was issued. You are required to maintain liability insurance in the amount listed below. This certificate may be revoked if you fail to keep proof of your insurance on file with DMV's Motor Carrier Services.

**SURETY BOND/IRREVOCABLE LETTER OF CREDIT** You were required to file a surety bond or an irrevocable letter of credit in the amount of \$25,000 before this certificate was issued. The bond/letter of credit is to protect the public from any potential loss or damage associated with the services you provide under the certificate. You are required to maintain the bond or letter of credit until November 20, 2028. Failure to do so may result in the revocation of this certificate.

**ADVERTISEMENT** The number of this certificate must appear in any advertisement for transportation service. Advertisements for your services may not contain untrue, misleading, or deceptive information.

**SPECIFIC SERVICE AND ROUTE REQUIREMENTS** You must transport passengers from a specific point or points of origin over regular routes to specific points of interest and back to the point or points of origin.

Each passenger must be issued a ticket which has printed the points of interest and the fare charged for the round trip.

Passengers will be transported only on round trips without stopover privileges.

No part of a fare will be refunded because of a passenger's refusal to complete the round trip.

**LEASING VEHICLES** Motor carriers are allowed to lease vehicles for their company's use in providing transportation services. A lease agreement must be executed between the lessor (vehicle owner) and lessee (motor carrier/holder of the operating authority certificate) for the vehicle to be used in the operation of the lessee's business.

For a lease agreement to be valid for for-hire operations, all of the following requirements must be met:

The leased vehicle must be insured by the licensed carrier's fleet coverage policy.

The licensed carrier must maintain operational control of the leased vehicle. This means all advertising and contracting must be completed in the name of the licensed carrier.

The for-hire vehicle registration card for the leased vehicle must reflect the certificate number

of the licensed carrier leasing the vehicle for use in that carrier's business.

A copy of the lease agreement must be carried in the vehicle at all times.

A motor carrier is not allowed to enter into arrangements authorizing others to operate a separate for-hire transportation business or service under their certificate. The practice is commonly referred to as "leasing authority" and is not legal in Virginia.
